



Mike Crapo Math and Science Scholarship

The Mike Crapo Math and Scholarship Fund was established by U.S. Senator Mike Crapo and provides scholarships to benefit Idaho students pursuing a degree in math or science at a higher education institution within the state.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Limited to residents of Idaho
- Students must be majoring in math or science (including, but not limited to, the area of engineering)
- Limited to students enrolled as a full-time student at the freshman level (first year) at a public or private four-year college or university in the state of Idaho
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above for all class work prior to the application.
 - *Note: Non-traditional students who have not been enrolled in a higher education institution for a period of three years shall be exempt from the cumulative GPA requirement for the first semester (or quarter) of the scholarship.*
- All students must maintain stated grade point for the first semester (or quarter) in order to receive a subsequent distribution.
